

Application Requirements

You should have at least one year of professional experience and an undergraduate degree. English language skills at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) are also required.

Required Documents

- Copies of the academic degree(s)
- Copy of the university entrance qualification (e.g. high school diploma)
- Copy of an official identity document
- CV in tabular form, starting age 16
- Copies of employment certificate(s) or evidence of previous professional experience
- Proof of English language proficiency (B2)

Fees and Financing

The fee for the study program is EUR 15,000. The amount is usually paid in four installments, but individual arrangements are also possible. For questions, please get in touch with the program coordinator.

Upon enrollment at the University of Potsdam, an additional semester fee of approximately EUR 300 per semester is due.

Application Deadlines

Summer Semester: classes starting in April

- For non-EU applicants needing a visa, the final recommended deadlines are: December 15th for the following summer semester
- For those not requiring a visa, the ultimate deadlines are: March 15th for the following summer semester

Winter Semester: classes starting in October

- For non-EU applicants needing a visa, the final recommended deadlines are: July 15th for the following winter semester
- For those not requiring a visa, the ultimate deadlines are: September 15th for the following winter semester
